Creative Practice Class Offerings for 2024

Art-

Visual arts and crafts, such as drawing, painting, and printmaking.

Beginning Guitar-

A course of study for students who have had little or no guitar training.

Intermediate/Advanced Guitar-

For students who have played for at least one year & have an introduction to reading notation

Drama-

Acting, stagecraft, drama games, and short skits for performance.

Wildwords-

Writing practice: journaling, poems, stories, songs, memoir, plays.

World Beat-

Hand drum and percussion rhythms from across the globe.

Yoga-

Breathing and postures to promote health and awareness.

Arnis-

Come explore this Filipino martial art with stick and open hand techniques

Ballet-

Explore basic ballet techniques: no experience necessary!

Ballet-Afrique-

Aerobic & energetic African Dance, embellished with basic ballet, modern, or jazz accents.

Medicine Trail-

Short hikes around the area, learning the local flora and fauna.

Cross Country-

Short runs, games, and plyometrics leading to a run up to Battleship Falls.
